SPECIALS (For all Primer, PreK, KKids, and School Age Students)

Monday: Manners, and a More Mindfulness Me- Our teachers will rotate Mindfulness Monday with stretching and yoga, character building traits such as table manners (in a fun and creative way), and community knowledge about our surroundings as well as tools we use in everyday life. They will be teaching about health and what it means for us to make healthy choices. Projects will be constructed, techniques will be learned, and communication and actions will be directed and fostered in a nurturing environment. Red Door Service Corp!- Community involvement is very important to Red Door. Together with the students, we will reach into our community to make it a better place. Cards for nursing home residents, Operation Christmas, planting flowers for our school, and so much more community outreach will take place during this time.

Tuesday: Dance- We have an LVPA dance student that comes to Red Door to instruct students in movement and dance. This time will be used to explore the love of music and movement.

Wednesday- Art- Our staff will expand your child's knowledge of art by offering creative ways to construct, build, and present projects. There will be discussion of various artists and ways their art has impacted our world.

Thursday: Cooking- Our staff is so excited to cook and create fun snacks with the students. The children will use measuring cups and any and all cooking utensils you can think of to create healthy, and sometimes even fun snacks! We will get to enjoy what we make on Friday!

Friday: Movie and our Treat- As excited as our students are to bake and create, they will be just as excited to eat! The snack our students prepare on Thursday, they will get to enjoy over a short movie that may promote a mindfulness trait learned from Monday.

Homework Club: Homework will be for all school age children from 3:45-4:30 daily, depending on what time your child gets off of the bus. Our staff will work with your child on all homework and make sure it is put back in backpacks and ready for the next day. A paper will be going home with your child to communicate directly to your child's teacher after the New Year. Please return this to us at Red Door. We at Red Door understand that all children learn differently and some may need to practice different skills more than others. We are asking your child's teacher what these skills are so we can also work to review them here at Red Door. Skills such as phonics, flashcards, and/or overall organization are all factors that can contribute to your child's success in school.
